The wearing of full and correct uniform at all times is essential as part of our commitment to maintain high standards.

The Prep. School uniform is predominantly the same as that of the Senior School with the exception of the blazer, jumper and tie. It is a good idea to purchase uniform with a bit of growing room to make sure you get good value.

For pupils, no jewellery is permitted other than a watch and one pair of plain gold or silver studs, which must be worn in the lobes, and which **must** be removed for PE.

All pupils must have a hairstyle that is both practical and appropriate. Hair must be tied back at all times. Hair bands must be a plain, single colour of black, maroon, grey or navy

only.

Bags

Pupils will need a plain black bag / bags for their books and other school equipment. They may be left neatly in form rooms. PE and games kit should be kept in school in either a gym bag or a plain black sports bag. Please note that when children progress to the Senior School they will need a plain black bag for school books or may use the SGS back pack. Boots / trainers can be carried in a separate boot bag if necessary.

Marking of clothes and belongings

All clothing and belongings must be clearly marked with the owner's name. Sports and P.E. kit can have the initials of their child embroidered at the time of purchase.

Summer or winter uniform may be worn in September. Winter uniform must be worn from 1st October until the Easter holidays. Summer uniform can be worn after Easter until 30th September.

PE

1. Earrings and watches must be removed. If earrings cannot be removed; written consent from parents and tape to cover the earring.
2. Notes must be provided if pupils are to be excused from lessons. Serious medical conditions or injuries are the only acceptable reasons for non-participation
3. PE staff must be notified if there is any medical condition which could affect a pupil's participation

Science and Art

A lab coat must be worn whilst working in the science labs. These will be provided by the Prep. school. For art and craft, overalls will be worn to protect uniform. These will also be provided by school.

ICT Devices

Every child will be provided with a school email address for use of Google Drive and Google Classroom. Children in Years 3-6 we operate a 'bring-your-own-device' policy and children are encouraged to bring in their own devices for use in lessons at the direction of the teacher.

Valuables

Pupils must take complete responsibility for their belongings, all of which should be named. The School cannot be held responsible for items lost or damaged. Expensive items brought in for a lesson must be handed into the office when not required. The School insurance only covers stolen articles where there is a proven break in.

Lost Property

Named property will be returned and unnamed property will be kept in the store room.
