SIXTH FORM UNIFORM

SIXTH FORM - GIRLS

- A plain navy tailored suit with either a skirt of sensible length (between 5 cm above the knee and 5 cm below the knee), or straight leg full length trousers
- Professional, office style blouses:
 - White (not cream)
 - Opaque (not see-through)
 - Short or long sleeved (not cap sleeves)
 - Poly-cotton fabric (not t-shirt material)
 - Non-revealing neckline
- Navy, black or natural coloured tights
- Black shoes of an appropriate style and height (no stiletto or kitten heels in science laboratories)
- Optional plain navy **V-necked** jumper
- Plain black or navy coat of an appropriate professional style
- Plain black bag
- Make-up and jewellery may be worn in moderation and to look professional

SIXTH FORM - BOYS

- Plain navy-blue suit
- White shirt
- Sixth Form tie * (can also be purchased from the school office as a single item)
- Black shoes

- Optional navy waistcoat / plain navy V-necked jumper
- Plain black or navy coat of an appropriate professional style
- Plain black bag

Sixth Form Games / PE Kit

A weekly Games session is compulsory for all Sixth Form students.

School PE kit must be worn and Sixth Form students will require:

- SGS blue polo shirt with collar*
- SGS navy shorts*
- SGS tracksuit top and bottoms* (optional for colder weather)

SENIOR SCHOOL (YEARS 7 - 11) UNIFORM

SENIOR SCHOOL – GIRLS

- Years 7 – 9 grey pleated skirt (between 5 cm above the knee and 5 cm below the knee) or grey tailored trousers (which must be from the uniform supplier) *
- Years 10 – 11 grey pleated skirt or grey pencil skirt (between 5 cm above the knee and 5 cm below the knee) or grey tailored trousers (which must be from the uniform supplier) *
- Grey jumper (with burgundy striped V-neck)*
- Years 7 – 9 white shirt-style long-sleeved blouse (traditional school style with a stiffened collar for wearing with a tie) *
- Years 10 – 11 white shirt-style $\frac{3}{4}$ length sleeved blouse *
- Tie * (can also be purchased from the school office as a single item)
- Tights:
 - Winter: Years 7 – 11 plain black tights or long grey socks

- Summer: Years 7 – 11 flesh coloured tights, or white ankle socks for Year 7-9
- Blazer with school badge *
- Plain black **shoes**, lace-up or slip-on. No stiletto or kitten heels. Maximum height 5 cm measured at the back. (Not sports branded)
- Plain black bag or rucksack (School bags available from the uniform supplier)
- Plain black or navy coat (School coats available from the uniform supplier)

Senior School girls can continue to wear this uniform all year, but the following items are alternative options from Easter to October half-term holiday:

- Plain white short-sleeved revere collar open-necked blouse (traditional school style)
- Plain flesh coloured tights or white ankle socks

SENIOR SCHOOL - BOYS

- Grey trousers *
- Grey jumper (with burgundy striped V-neck)*
- White long-sleeved shirt (traditional school style with stiffened collar)
- Tie * (can also be purchased from the school office as a single item)
- Blazer with school badge *
- Plain grey or black socks
- Plain black **shoes**, lace-up or slip on (Not sports branded)
- Plain black bag or rucksack (School bags available from the uniform supplier)
- Plain black or navy coat (School coats available from the uniform supplier)

Senior School boys can continue to wear this uniform all year, but the following items are alternative options from Easter to October half-term holiday:

- White short-sleeved traditional school style shirt with stiffened collar *

PE KIT

PE Kit - Girls

- Plain navy or black sports bag (School bags are available from the uniform supplier)
- PE socks – short and plain white*
- SGS navy shorts*
- SGS navy skort*
- Trainers – non-marking – indoor
- Trainers – outdoor
- SGS blue polo shirt with collar*
- Hockey socks – navy*
- Football boots
- Shin pads
- SGS Tracksuit top and bottoms*
- Mouth guards

Optional Items - Girls:

- Hockey stick

PE Kit - Boys

- Plain navy or black sports bag (school branded bags are also available from the uniform supplier)

- PE socks – short and plain white*
- SGS navy shorts *
- SGS blue polo shirt with collar*
- Trainers – non-marking soles – indoor
- Trainers – outdoor
- Football/rugby/hockey socks – blue*
- SGS rugby shirt *
- Football boots
- Shin pads
- SGS Tracksuit top and bottoms*
- Mouth guards

PE Notes - ALL PUPILS

- All jewellery must be removed (including watches)
- Notes must be provided if pupils are to be excused from lessons. Serious medical conditions or injuries are the only acceptable reasons for non-participation
- PE staff must be notified if there is any medical condition which could affect a pupil's participation

MOBILE PHONE POUCHES

All pupils from Year 7 to 11 must also purchase a YONDR mobile phone pouch if they wish to bring their mobile phone to school. These are priced at £30 (inc. VAT).

This will be automatically invoiced to parents of new pupils of the school, unless parents inform the school that their child will not be bringing a mobile phone to school.

Please be aware that if pupils lose their YONDR mobile phone pouch, a new one will need to be purchased from the school.

SENIOR SCHOOL – ACCESSORIES & HAIRSTYLES

For pupils in Years 7 – 11, no jewellery other than watches is permitted, apart from one pair of plain gold or silver studs for girls, which **must** be worn in the ear lobes and **must** be removed for PE.

All pupils must have a hairstyle that is both practical and appropriate. Hair must be tied back when necessary for practical subjects. For all pupils below the Sixth Form, hair must be one colour that appears to be a natural shade. Spikes or other unnatural looking styles are not acceptable. Hair styles created with gel or similar products are not acceptable.

No make-up is permitted below the Sixth Form.

ALL PUPILS

Devices - All pupils are required to bring a device to school, either a laptop or tablet device with keyboard. The brand of device is entirely at parents' discretion, and the school can make recommendations if required.
